In celebration of 100 years of workers' compensation in Georgia from 1920 to 2020, the Honorable Frank R. McKay, Chairman of the State Board of Workers' Compensation, along with Board Directors, Honorable Benjamin J. Vinson and Honorable Terry H. Chastain, and Executive Director, Delece A. Brooks, will visit select cities throughout Georgia as part of the SBWC 2020 Regional Educational Series. Under their leadership, the Board will host five seminars providing valuable information for those impacted by the Georgia workers' compensation system including employers, self-insurers, human resource and risk managers, insurance claims adjusters, rehabilitation specialists, medical service providers, workers' compensation attorneys, paralegals and other system participants.

The 2020 centennial celebration will include an address from the Chairman highlighting legislative and Board Rule changes, the annual case law update from local administrative law judges, claimants' and defense attorneys explaining recent developments in Georgia law, as well as Board ICMS II and EDI updates. Additionally, the innovative and energetic Public Education Committee - composed of attorneys and other workers' compensation industry experts - will present a fictional mediation of a workers' compensation claim, live on stage, including fast-paced coverage of 20 current issues in workers' compensation claims for 2020 in 20 minutes! As part of the mediation, a claimant's visit to the authorized treating physician's office will be reenacted by the Public Education Committee's "not-ready-for-prime-time" players which will include a number of medical issues such as expedited medical treatment, return to suitable work, intervening and superadded injuries, and change in condition. Finally, the closing segment will encourage lively audience participation designed to create new fact patterns and alternatives for resolution of the fictional claim through mediation. You do not want to miss this seminar!
